Annual Mine Rescue and First Aid Competition

The District of Elkford approved the free use of District facilities and coordination of in-kind use of District equipment for the 94th Annual Mine Rescue and First Aid competition to be held in Elkford, May 9, 2015. This year the organizers are hoping to host not only the competition but also the awards banquet in Elkford.

Wapiti Ski Hill Operating Agreement

The District applied for a new 30-year Operating Agreement to replace the existing License of Occupation to allow for the uses contemplated by the Wapiti Ski Hill Resort Master Plan. Council approved the agreement with the Province.

Sidewalk Maintenance and Repair Policy

Council approved establishing the Sidewalk Maintenance and Repair Policy. The policy establishes a set of formal guidelines to deal with annual inspections of the sidewalk infrastructure and to record defects and hazards found during the annual inspections or reported by the public.

Bylaws

Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 763, 2014

This bylaw was adopted and includes the following:

- Commercial opportunities in conjunction with institutional uses;
- Amendments to the Floodplain and Wildfire Development Permit Area requirements to provide clarity when determining when professional reports are required;
- Temporary Use Permits defined;
- Development Approval Information Area defined.
