Elkford Community Enhancement Society, Introduction

A delegation from the Society introduced themselves to Council and highlighted their goals and plans. Boivin Trail

Council reviewed and discussed concerns brought forth from Elkford residents about the Boivin Trail being a multi-purpose trail (permitting off-road motorized vehicles). As the dike work continues in the vicinity of the trail, the final configuration of the trails along Boivin Creek has not been finalized. Council postponed further assessment of the topic until the dike work is completed.
