CanAus Coal – Michel Creek Project Update

A four person team from CanAus Coal presented an update on the activities in the Michel Creek Mine Project that will be located near the Coal Mountain Operations. The company continues to develop their concept design for the mine and to consult with the neighbouring communities and other stakeholders. The construction stage of the project is planned for 2018-19 and the first coal is expected to be produced in 2020-21.

Ball Diamonds Improvements

Council provided an early 2016 budget approval for shale upgrades to the Elkford Ball Diamonds. This is in preparation for the 2016 Softball Alberta U16 Girls' Provincials that will be held in Elkford, July 8 to 10, 2016, as organized by the Elkford Minor Ball Association.

Regional Community to Community Forum

The District of Elkford will participate in the Community to Community Forum in Cranbrook. The forum will be hosted by the Regional District of East Kootenay and the Ktunaxa Nation and may include other municipal governments in the region.

Bylaws

The District of Elkford Subdivision and Development Servicing Bylaw No. 776, 2016 received its first reading. This bylaw will regulate the subdivision and development process when considering the creation of new parcels of land or larger scale developments. The bylaw will be referred to external agencies for comments before it is submitted to Council for a second and third reading.
