RCMP Presentation of the 2016 First Quarter Crime Statistics

Cpl. Bob Wright presented crime statistics for the District of Elkford. The report represented some of the calls for police service within the District in the first quarter of 2016. Areas of enforcement discussed included speeding on Highway 43, roll over simulator presentation at the Elkford Secondary School, domestic violence training, drug abuse school presentations, and school zone safety.

Development Variance Permit (DVP)

Council approved the DVP for a proposed daycare operation to be located at 924 Alpine Way.

Finning (Canada) – Land Sale

Council approved the sale of several lots on Bear Paw Crescent to Finning (Canada).

Youth Action Network Commission

The District will form the Youth Action Network Commission, as an oversight body of the Elkford Youth Network.
