### **Council Youth Representatives**

### **RCMP Presentation of the 2017 Third Quarter Crime Statistics**

Cpl. Bob Wright presented crime statistics for the District of Elkford. The report represented some of the calls for police service within the District during the third quarter of 2017. Areas of enforcement discussed included noise complaints and traffic check stops. Cpl. Wright also indicated that the Elk Valley will welcome three new members to the detachment in the coming weeks and reminds the public that the Elkford RCMP Detachment Office continues to be open on Tuesdays only.
