Draft Community Wildfire Protection Plan (CWPP) Update

Tove Pashkowski of B.A. Blackwell & Associates Ltd. presented a draft Community Wildfire Protection Plan for discussion. Council reviewed the plan and provided feedback. This plan updates the District's 2006 CWPP. The plan will be finalized and brought for Council's consideration and approval at the December 11, 2017 Regular meeting.

RoadWatchBC Project Update
