



## Lifesaving Society Bronze Programs

### STAR

Candidates are taught about how to make water smart choices and learn basic lifesaving and resuscitation skills needed to be their own personal lifeguard. Also developing entry level endurance skills with a 400m timed swim.

**\*Prerequisites: 8 - 12 years old, able to swim in deep water.**

### MEDALLION

Candidates learn advanced lifesaving techniques for challenging rescues of increased risk, involving conscious and unconscious victims in varying water depth. Candidates develop stroke efficiency and endurance in 500m timed swim. Includes CPR-A

### CROSS

Candidates develop proficiency at performing patient assessments, managing aquatic spinal injuries, and preventing the loss of life in a variety of aquatic emergencies while developing endurance training and fitness skills. Includes CPR-C and two grade 11 high school credits.

**\*Prerequisite: Bronze Medallion**

### SFA / CPR-C / AED

Standard First Aid is the most comprehensive first aid training program for the general public and is also a prerequisite for the National Lifeguard Program.

Candidates develop the skills and knowledge needed to assess and provide basic life support to patients with airway, breathing, or circulation emergencies as well as how to manage musculoskeletal and environmental emergencies.

### NATIONAL LIFEGUARD: POOL

National Lifeguard Pool Certification is designed to develop the fundamental values, judgment, knowledge, skills and fitness required by lifeguards. The NL course emphasizes the principles of lifesaving while teaching the candidate the importance of the decision-making processes which will assist in providing the most effective and safe swimming pool environment.

**\*Prerequisites: SFA, Bronze Cross, and must be 16 on last day of course (Prerequisites *must* be proved on *first day* of course)**
