District to Provide Letter of Support to the Elkford Arts Council in its Application for Public Art Grant Funding

The Arts Council is hoping to be successful in obtaining the grant funding that will be used to install a permanent piece of art at the Elkford Community Conference Centre.

Bylaws

- **District of Elkford Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 808, 2018** received its first two readings. This Bylaw will regulate cannabis dispensaries and production facilities in Elkford.
- **District of Elkford Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 809, 2018** received its first two readings. This Bylaw will allow the re-designation of a neighborhood commercial mixed-use property to a neighbourhood residential intensification use.
- **District of Elkford Official Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 810, 2018** received its first two readings. This Bylaw will allow the rezoning of a property from C-3 neighbourhood commercial to two R-1 single-unit residential properties.
- **District of Elkford Official Business Licence Amendment Bylaw No. 811, 2018** received its first two readings. This Bylaw will amend the District's Business Licence Bylaw to include cannabis dispensaries, cannabis production facilities and medical marihuana production facilities.
