Elkford Fire Department Service Operations

The District established Elkford Fire Rescue to be a Full Service Operations Department as per the Structure Firefighters Competency and Training Playbook established in 2014 by the BC Fire Commissioner. A full Service Operation Level will allow for exterior and interior operations on all structure types.

Bylaws

The following bylaws were considered by Council:

2016 – 2020 Five Year Financial Plan Bylaw No. 784, 2016 – the bylaw received its first three readings.

Tax Rate Bylaw No. 785, 2016 received its first three readings. The bylaw sets the property tax rates for 2016.

Bear Paw Crescent Highway Closure Bylaw No. 786, 2016 received its first two readings. The bylaw will close part of the Bear Paw cul-de-sac as part of a land development proposal from Finning (Canada).
