### **Bylaws**

The following bylaws were adopted:

- Urban Wildlife Management Bylaw No. 754, 2014. This bylaw prohibits feeding of urban wildlife and manages human-wildlife interactions.
- Ticket Information Utilization Amendment Bylaw No. 755, 2014. This bylaw provides for schedule of fines related to the Urban Wildlife Management Bylaw.
- Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 759, 2014. This bylaw introduces the new fee for refuse pick up during the Spring Clean-up.

### Water and Sewer Reserve Replenishment Parcel Tax Bylaws

In 2014, the District is implementing Parcel Taxes for the long-term replacement of the Water and Sewer Systems infrastructure. All parcels of land that are connected or have the ability to connect to these system will receive the parcel tax. The District established the Parcel Tax Review Panel and gave first three readings to the new bylaws.
