In-Kind Use of Multi-Purpose Hall Approved

Council approved in-kind use of the Multi-Purpose Hall in the Recreation Centre for the popular Parent and Fun Times Program that runs from September to May.

District to Submit Application for Grant from the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program

Council supported an application for an estimated \$8.7 million grant from the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program. If obtained, the funding will be used for the replacement of underground infrastructure in Abruzzi Heights (Middletown).

Council Remuneration Policy

The District of Elkford approved the amended Council Remuneration Policy which establishes the next four years (2019 to 2022) of Council remuneration. In 2019, the annual rate for the Mayor will be \$20,992 and for each Council member \$10,176.

Bylaws

- **District of Elkford Water Service Amendment Bylaw No. 813, 2018** was adopted. This Bylaw allows the addition of a bulk water rate for the provision of water to be transported to customers requiring large volumes of non-potable water.
- **District of Elkford Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 814, 2018** received its first two readings. This Bylaw will regulate the places where people are permitted to smoke and will include regulations for smoking cannabis.
