Flood Protection Program Agreement

The District of Elkford entered into the Building Canada Fund Flood Protection Program agreement with the Province for the Boivin Creek Dike and Bank Improvement Project. This project is to be completed in 2015 at an estimated cost of \$2.4 million with 2/3 of the funding being contributed through this grant program.

Bylaws

Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 763, 2014

This amendment will include the following:

- Commercial opportunities in conjunction with institutional uses;
- Amendments to the Floodplain and Wildfire Development Permit Area requirements to provide clarity when determining when professional reports are required;
- Temporary Use Permits defined;
- Development Approval Information Area defined.

The Bylaw received its first reading and will be referred to outside agencies and Elkford's Citizen Advisory Committee. Prior to adoption, a Public Hearing process will be conducted to receive comments from the public.

Firearms Regulation Bylaw No. 747, 2014

This Bylaw will make slight modifications to the boundary in which discharge of firearms is prohibited within the District of Elkford, and provide a new definition of firearm. The Bylaw received its second and third reading and is scheduled for adoption on July 28, 2014.

Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 762, 2014

The Amendment includes two items:

- Commissioner for Taking Affidavits fee changed to \$10 per appointment;
- Land Title Search fee established at \$10 per document.

This bylaw has now been adopted.
