District to Submit Grant Applications: Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program for Abruzzi Heights Infrastructure Replacement and Round Prairie Bridge Replacement

The Province's Investing in Canada Infrastructure Grant Program supports cost-sharing of infrastructure projects in British Columbia communities. This grant program focusses on four key areas:

- Community, culture and recreation infrastructure
- Rural and northern communities infrastructure
- Green infrastructure
- Public transit

Council supported a grant application to the Rural and Northern Communities Program. If successful, the funding will be used toward the replacement of infrastructure in Abruzzi Heights (Middletown).

In addition, Council supported a grant application to the Community, Culture and Recreation Program. If successful, the funding will be used for the replacement of the Round Prairie Bridge that was lost to the 2013 flood.
